Dear Margaux:

Congratulations! Due to your performances and per the USA Pentathlon Athlete Selection Procedures, you have been nominated to the UIPM for the XXIX Olympic Games in Beijing, China.

On June 2, 2008 the UIPM issued Olympic Invitation letters to all of the National Olympic Committees with the names of athletes that have qualified for the XXIX Olympic Games in Beijing, China.

The letter received by the U.S. Olympic Committee had three female athletes (Michelle Kelly, Sheila Taormina and yourself) and one male athlete (Eli Bremer) listed as qualified for the Olympic Games. The maximum quota each country can send to the Olympic Games is two per gender. Therefore, to determine the two qualified female athletes to be submitted to the UIPM, the selection committee followed the USA Pentathlon Athlete Selection Procedures for the 2008 Olympic Games, approved on March 29, 2007 and Amended on January 23, 2008. Section I.D. of those Procedures provided for a tie-breaker process based on the 2008 UIPM World Cup Point Standings.

The result of the tie-breaker had you in the second position and thus qualifying to be one of the two names submitted to the UIPM.

In the coming days and weeks, additional information will be passed along with specific details for the Olympic Games.

Again, congratulations on your amazing accomplishment and we look forward to working with you through the Olympic Games.
